REGULATIONS



1. Material

- Gravel and mountain bikes are allowed.
- E-Bikes are not allowed.
- Each participant must wear a helmet during the whole event.
- Each participant must carry a working, charged, and turned on cell phone at all times during the event
- SOS emergency blanket and first aid kit belongs to the mandatory material.

2. Traffic Rules & Rules of Conduct

- Gravel Trans Jura takes place on public roads, paths and trails as well as on private property.
 Courtesy and consideration for other participants, as well as for pedestrians and all other road users is a matter of course.
- Participants must respect the road traffic regulations.
- It is important to ride on the roads and paths on the right hand side.

3. Waste

Waste does not belong in nature but in your own pockets and later in waste garbage cans.

4. Emergency & first aid in case of accident

- In case of an accident of another participant, each participant commits himself to provide first aid. Disregarding of this rule leads to disqualification.
- It is mandatory to have the app EchoSOS on your mobile phone: https://echosos.com/en/ The app EchoSOS can be used in an emergency to call the ambulance directly and be located.
- There is an event emergency number, which is in operation 24 hours. The exact number will be communicated later.

5. Course

- The route covers around 400 kilometers and 11,000 meters of altitude.
- The detailed route will be communicated to all participants about 2 months before the event.
- There will be official check points along the way. The exact number and location will be communicated two months before the event.

6. Timekeeping

- Riding at night is not allowed. The officially permitted driving times are from 6:00 am to max.
 9:30 pm.
- There is a time measurement. This is used for the finisher list and the corresponding diploma.
- There is no ranking.
- The finish in Nyon is supervised daily from 10.00 to 21.30.

7. Time limits

• The last possible arrival time in Nyon is 6 p.m. on Wednesday, June 5.

8. Opening event Baden

• It is mandatory to register on Thursday, May 30, 2024 in Baden and attend the opening event, including the official briefing.

9. Refreshment

Food on the way is the responsibility of the participants.

10. Overnight stay

• The official road map of the Gravel Trans Jura shows all the accommodation available along the route - whether hotel or simple camping. Wild camping & bivouacking is prohibited.

 - 1. Transfer of the participation fee to the year 2025
 - 2. Refund of the participation fee, minus 20 CHF administration costs
 - 3. Donation of the participation fee in favor of the event
