REGULATIONS

1. Material

- Gravel and mountain bikes are allowed.
- E-Bikes are not allowed.
- Each participant must wear a helmet during the whole event.
- Each participant must carry a working, charged, and turned on cell phone at all times during the event.
- SOS emergency blanket and first aid kit belongs to the mandatory material.

2. Traffic Rules & Rules of Conduct

- Gravel Trans Jura takes place on public roads, paths and trails as well as on private property. Courtesy and consideration for other participants, as well as for pedestrians and all other road users is a matter of course.
- Participants must respect the road traffic regulations.
- It is important to ride on the roads and paths on the right hand side.

3. Waste

- Waste does not belong in nature but in your own pockets and later in waste garbage cans.

4. Emergency & first aid in case of accident

- In case of an accident of another participant, each participant commits himself to provide first aid. Disregarding of this rule leads to disqualification.
- It is mandatory to have the app EchoSOS on your mobile phone: <https://echosos.com/en/>
The app EchoSOS can be used in an emergency to call the ambulance directly and be located.
- There is an event emergency number, which is in operation 24 hours. The number is 079 719 26 91 and can be viewed at any time on the event app.

5. Course

- The route covers around 400 kilometers and 11,000 meters of altitude.
- The detailed route will be communicated to all participants at the latest two months before the event.
- There will be official checkpoints along the way. The exact number and location will be communicated two months before the event.

6. Timekeeping

- Riding at night is not allowed. The officially permitted driving times are from 6:00 am to max. 9:30 pm.
- There is no time measurement. Scanning the QR code at the start, finish and checkpoints is for safety reasons and to issue a finisher diploma.
- There is no ranking.
- The finish in Nyon is supervised daily from 11.00 to 21.30.

7. Time limits

- The last possible arrival time in Nyon is 6 p.m. on Wednesday, June 10.

8. Opening event Baden

- It is mandatory to register on the day before the start, on June 4, 2026 in Baden and to take part in the opening event, including an official briefing.

9. Refreshment

- Food on the way is the responsibility of the participants.

10. Overnight stay

- The official road map and the event-app of the Gravel Trans Jura shows all the accommodation available along the route - whether hotel or simple camping. Wild camping & bivouacking is prohibited.

11. Participants Disclaimer

- By registering, the participant accepts the terms and conditions:

By entering the event, the participant accepts the event infrastructure that he/she uses. Participation is at your own risk. The organizer assumes no responsibility or liability for accidents in connection with the event. The participant accepts this exclusion of liability and confirms that he/she has an internationally valid liability and accident insurance. Furthermore, he/she confirms that his/her own equipment is in impeccable condition. The organizer assumes no responsibility or liability for damage or theft in connection with the participant's equipment. The participant confirms that he/she is in perfect health. All picture and film rights belong to the organizer. Image and film material may be used for promotional purposes of own events.

12. Refund of entry fees

- Those who cannot start are not entitled to a refund of the entry fee.
- Until two months before the event (Friday, April 10, 2025) the starting place can be transferred to another person. The handling fee is CHF 20.00.

13. Cancellation of the event

- If the event is cancelled, participants have the following options:
 1. Transfer of the participation fee to the year 2027
 2. Refund of the participation fee, minus 20 CHF administration costs
 3. Donation of the participation fee in favor of the event
